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Post Operative Care & Schedule Planning

Following Placement of the BAHA System

The first 24 hours:

During the first 24 hours after surgery, leave head bandage in place over the foam dressing and healing cap. Avoid any movement of this bandage during the first 24 hours after surgery.

After 24 hours the bandage should be removed. The dressing under the bandage should be left in place. Hair can be washed, but dressing must be kept dry.

10-14 Days after surgery:

An appointment will be scheduled with your doctor 10-14 days after surgery.

At this time the healing cap, dressing, and sutures may be removed. Gently clean any dried blood and scabs, and hair can be washed. If the healing is complete, no further dressing should be necessary.
